3: HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Hazard Information: Flammable.

Harmful: danger of serious damage to health by prolonged exposure through inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed.

Toxic: danger of very serious irreversible effects through inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed.

Causes burns.

May cause sensitization by skin contact.

May cause cancer.

4: FIRST AID MEASURES

Eyes: Irrigate immediately with copious quantities of water for 15 minutes, Eyelids should be held away from the eyeball to ensure thorough rinsing. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water or suitable skin cleanser as soon as possible for 10 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing. Obtain medical advice if skin disorder develop.

Inhaation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. If conscious, ensure the casualty sits or lies down. If breathing becomes bubbly, have the casualty sit and provide oxygen if available. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give 1 pint of water to drink immediately. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

5: FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Flash Point: 35 °C.

Special Exposure Hazards: In case of fire toxic fumes will be formed (amines), Carbon oxides and Nitrogen oxides.

Extinguishing Media: Powder, carbon dioxide, foam, water mist (only large amounts).

Personal Protective Equipment: Wear protectiv clothing and use self-contained breathing apparatus.

6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions: Put on adequate protective equipment.

Environmental Precautions: Keep away from drains, surface-water, ground-water and soil.

Decontamination Procedures: Collect as much as possible in a container for disposal. Cover the remainder with inert absorbent. Disposal according to local regulations.

7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Do not breathe vapour. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Storage: Keep in a dry cool ventilated place. Di-

rect sunshine should be avoided.

Keep away from ignition sources - No smoking.

Keep container tightly closed.

Keep at temperatures between 2 °C and 25 °C.
